Messages from Right Reverend Patrick Joseph McKinney – Bishop of Nottingham

Justice and Peace Assembly - The diocesan Justice and Peace Commission's Annual Assembly and AGM takes place on **Saturday 10th November 2018 at St Hugh's Church, Lincoln**. The day will begin with Mass at which I will preside, followed by formation, networking and inspiration on the Church's response to the modern world's environmental crisis. Speakers include Graham Gordon, Head of Policy at CAFOD. I would urge you to let your parishioners know about this event and advertise it in your parish newsletters.

World Day of Prayer for the Poor- The Holy Father has set aside **18th November** for this intention.
