## Modern Day Slavery in the UK – A

talk by the Medaille Trust on Wednesday 16th January at Our Lady of Lourdes Parish Centre, Mickleover @7.30pm. The talk will address what is Modern Day Slavery in 21st Century Britain, the role of the safe house and what individuals/communities can do to prevent slavery. The Medaille Trust was established by Roman Catholic religious orders to help women, men and dependent children who are victims of modern slavery in the UK, enabling them to regain their dignity and self-worth. They do this by providing safe housing and offering opportunities for physical and psychological healing and rehabilitation.

**CAFOD CONNECT2 BRAZIL** – CAFOD's CONNECT2 programme finished at the end of 2018. It started in 2011 and the first project we as a parish supported was CONNECT2 Cambodia. Between 2011 and 2014 we raised £5,000 for Cambodia. We then moved to another project, CONNECT2 Brazil, and we have raised £4,386.83. Many thanks to all of you who contributed to this.

We have now been asked to support Hands On, a project with young people in Colombia. We will receive more details of this project shortly. So from now on money raised for CAFOD in the parish will go to this project. Our main way of fundraising is through the CAFOD envelopes (available at the back of church) which can be placed in the weekly collection at Sunday mass. Many thanks again for your generous support.

**Project Arusha** – Jemimah Tumelty, Danae Guererro, Jacob McCalla and Danny Eames landed in Arusha earlier this week. They will spend around ten weeks teaching in the schools associated with the project. We are sure that they will learn a lot from the experience and will be keen to share it with you all in April when they return.

## Brexit and the Catholic Church – As

you will be aware, Brexit is causing uncertainty and concern to many EU citizens living in the UK. Both clergy and laity alike share this uncertainty and concern. Apart from those who are uncertain about their future, others are inevitably in a state of ignorance and unaware that Brexit will affect their immigration status. In March 2019, the Government is due to launch a Settlement Scheme. All EU citizens living in the UK will be required to make an application if they wish to remain here after Brexit. However, Irish citizens will not be required to apply as their rights are separately protected. With such a diverse diocese this shall affect many of our parishioners, priests and religious sisters. Please pray for them all during this time of uncertainty. The Bishops conference has made representations on these issues to ministers and through the Home Office working groups set up to discuss the Settlement Scheme. We will continue to do so as it is implemented. Finally we urge the whole Catholic community to take up Pope Francis' call to “welcome, promote and protect our brothers and sisters who have made their homes here with us”.

### **Faith in Politics Internship Scheme for 2019**

The Catholic Parliamentary and Public Affairs Internship Scheme is recruiting at least six recently graduated Catholics to learn from an intensive experience of political and social action in a spiritual context. The scheme will run from September 2019 until July 2020. Internship positions are given with Christian MPs and Peers in Parliament, the Catholic Education Service, CAFOD and the Caritas Social Action Network. All interns also gain from retreats and spiritual guidance, as well as living in a vibrant, young Catholic community in the center of London. During the year, as part of their overall formation, interns will study for a Postgraduate Certificate in Catholic Social Teaching from St Mary’s University, Twickenham.
