The Holy Father's Prayer Intentions for November- Universal

In Service of Peace-That the language of love may prevail over the language of conflict. Noon on 1st November to midnight on 2nd November, a plenary indulgence may be gained, applicable to the holy souls only. Conditions: visit to a church say there an Our Father and one of the Creeds, and the usual conditions of confession, Holy Communion, and prayer for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and one Hail Mary). The Indulgence may only be gained once a day. A partial indulgence may be gained between 1-8 November, applicable to the Holy Souls only (visiting a cemetery and praying there for the dead under the usual conditions).
